### **Who can nominate a leader for this award?**

A coworker, parent, teacher or community representative in the field of early childhood.

Educators may also nominate themselves.

### **What are the requirements for a nominee?**

- An educator who works directly with children in one of the following settings: family child care programs, preschool programs (public or private), child care centers, school-age programs, or Head Start.
- A minimum of three years in a licensed early childhood program (including the settings listed above)
- A minimum of a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential in progress or higher

### **When is the nomination form due?**

All nominations are due by Sept. 3, 2019.

### **When and where will the award be given?**

On Oct. 26, 2019, at the Leadership and Early Childhood Conference at the Sharonville Convention Center.
