Who can nominate a leader for this award?

A coworker, parent, teacher or community representative in the field of early childhood. Educators may also nominate themselves.

What are the requirements for a nominee?

- An educator who works directly with children in one of the following settings: family child care programs, preschool programs (public or private), child care centers, school-age programs, or Head Start.
- A minimum of three years in a licensed early childhood program (including the settings listed above)
- A minimum of a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential in progress or higher

When is the nomination form due?

All nominations are due by Sept. 3, 2019.

When and where will the award be given?

On Oct. 26, 2019, at the Leadership and Early Childhood Conference at the Sharonville

Convention Center.
